FIRST IN MY CLASS.

No. 9, measures 48-49 (vamp)

Valedictorian of Wayzata High School, nineteen seventy eight. After that, I went to Yale, where I graduated Magna Cum Laude in political science in nineteen eighty two.

HARRIS steps forward to join KLOBUCHAR in solidarity and tell her own story.

HARRIS

That same year I was beginning my second year at Howard University. And by the time I was a senior in the fall of 1984, I couldn't wait to vote in my very first presidential election. For there, on the ballot, was a woman's name —

KLOBUCHAR, HARRIS

Geraldine Ferraro.

HARRIS

True, she wasn't at the top of the ticket...

KLOBUCHAR

And true, she didn't win...

HARRIS

But simply knowing that she had been nominated by a major political party to be vice president was, to me, proof that our country was ready for women to be in charge.

KLOBUCHAR

As the mid eighties became the late eighties...

HARRIS

A supposed new era of equality, by the way...

KLOBUCHAR

I earned my Doctor of Jurisprudence law degree from the University of Chicago...

HARRIS

And I earned my Doctor of Jurisprudence law degree from the University of California, San Francisco...

KLOBUCHAR, HARRIS

And I was ready to conquer the world.

KLOBUCHAR

Afterall, Melanie Griffith had shown us the way in "Working Girl."

HARRIS

Alas, like so many other happy ending movies, it was just a fantasy.

KLOBUCHAR

For the world was still spewing the same sexist messages from the sixties...

HARRIS

Only those messages had been repurposed to address and assert power over the growing number of women in the workplace and government. Yes, with every one rung I climbed on the ladder of success, there'd be a hundred people — both men and women — trying to pull me down, making sure that I knew that...

For the following lyrics in quotation marks, HARRIS takes on the voice and demeanor of a stereotypical sexist man.

Also relating to what is being shared, GABBARD/WARREN now steps forward to join the other women.

Now, I didn't think it would be another three decades until a woman became the first major party nominee for president.

And on November eighth, twenty sixteen, like millions of other Americans, I was glued to the television, ready to celebrate and witness history. But as night stretched into early morning, the country sent me - and all women - a harsh but very familiar message.

For a moment KLOBUCHAR, HARRIS, and GABBARD/WARREN seem stunned — a mix of disbelief, anger and sadness.

But now, hope and resolve returns to their voices.

FIVE MILLION WOMEN MARCHED AND THAT'S WHEN ALL MY DOUBTS JUST DISAPPEARED AND MY CONVICTIONS GREW MUCH STRONGER.
